My answer is....

### White Christmas

1 oz. Polar Ice Vodka  
¼ oz. Cointreau  
3 oz. White Cranberry juice  
Shake and serve with frozen white cranberries

### Wonderful Life Martini

1 oz. Stolichnaya Vodka  
¼ oz. Stolichnaya Vanilla Vodka  
½ oz. Talea  
¼ oz. Crème de cacao  
Garnish with a light dusting of Cinnamon Powder and Chocolate shavings

### Ginger Bread Martini

¾ oz. Goldschlager  
½ oz. Talea  
¼ oz. Chocolate Milk  
Splash of Stolichnaya Vanilla Vodka  
Serve with a thirsty ginger bread man on the side

### Christmas In The Caribbean

1 oz. Bacardi Coco Rum  
1 oz. Passion Fruit juice  
½ oz. Mango Juice  
1 oz. Pineapple/Coconut juice  
Build On Ice With a Splash Of Grenadine  
Serve while listening to Mele Kalikimaka performed by Jimmy Buffett!

### Polar Bear Shot

1/3 oz. Polar Ice Vodka  
1/3 oz. Crème De Cacao (White)  
1/3 oz. Crème De Menthe (White)  
Garnish with a fresh mint leaf on the top of the glass

### Morning Glory

3 oz. Perrier Jouette Champagne  
2 oz. Passion Fruit juice  
1 oz. Mango Juice

Garnish with finely diced strawberries that will dance up and down on the bubbles.

Serve in a champagne flute using chilled juice
